



# Immunization Policy: Exemption Statement

## Policy Compliance Form for Students with Exemptions or Exceptions

*In Compliance with Oklahoma Statutes, Title 70 §3242*

**Exemptions and Exceptions:** State law allows for certain exemptions based upon medical contraindications, religious or moral objections. The Board of Regents, in its discretion, includes exceptions to the requirement for vaccinations for each of the following categories of students. Additionally, the immunization requirement shall not apply to students enrolling in courses delivered through the *Internet* or at *distance learning sites* which the student is not required to attend class on campus.

**McCurtain County Campus and Web Campus Students:** Please note that students attending the McCurtain County campus or seeking degrees by Web are not required to submit the Immunization Compliance Form. The student's academic record will be marked as MCU or WEB to designate Exemption Status.

If Other, Check One Exemption Below: "Student has or is ...":

- attended one or more years in a public or private accredited institution (i.e. has completed, prior to current enrollment term, at least two 16 week semester terms);
- concurrently enrolled high school students;
- graduated from a high school in a state that requires vaccinations for hepatitis B, measles, mumps, and rubella;
- transferring from an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or private institution of higher learning located within this state and accredited pursuant to Section 4103 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- enrolling at *Higher Education Centers or other learning sites* authorized by The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. Such sites include, but are not necessarily limited to , the McCurtain County Higher Education Center, business and community outreach classes (students are not required to submit Compliance Form);
- born before January 1, 1956;
- a member of a *National Guard Unit or Military Reserve Unit* or who is currently on *active duty* in a branch of the United States military, and
- enrolling in *web-based courses* or at a distance learning site.
