The CASC Foundation administers a number of private scholarships that are funded and awarded by individuals, agencies and organizations. Donors set scholarship requirements and the CASC Scholarship Committee/Foundation Board selects the recipients. Scholars Program recipients must be single and non-parent. Recipients must pre-enroll for the following fall semester of classes as a full-time student during the April enrollment period. Scholarships are subject to availability of funds based on donor contributions.

***Renewal of multi-semester scholarships is contingent upon:**

- * Completing 30 credit hours within a year.
- * Maintaining a 3.0 GPA.
- * Maintaining a course load of 12 or more hours.
- * Pre-enrollment of four consecutive semesters.

***Scholarships do not include fees.**

Scholarships are based on availability of funds and will be awarded on a first-come, first-enrolled basis. Scholarship recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student. Priority given to entering freshmen unless otherwise designated. Scholars Program selection may differ.
