### Explanation of Add/Drop Dates

**LAST DAY TO DROP without Charges or Grade (Drop Date):** Students may drop course with 100% refund and have no grade recorded to the transcript.

**LAST DAY TO DROP with AUTOMATIC "W" Grade:** Students may drop course with zero refund and "W" grade posted to the transcript.

**LAST DAY TO DROP with "W" or "F" Grade:** Students may drop course with zero refund and "F" or "W" grade (instructor assigns F or W grade).

**60 % Withdrawal Date:** Students who accept financial aid through Pell Grant, SEOG Grant, Subsidized Stafford Loan, Unsubsidized Stafford Loan or a Parent PLUS Loan may be required to payback all or part of their aid when withdrawal or last date of attendance is made before the 60% of the semester. **Note:** Students should contact the Financial Aid Office when dropping below full-time hours or all classes in the term.

**COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL:** Students who need to drop **all** classes after the **Drop Date** and before the **60% Withdrawal Date** must contact the Student Success Center, and Financial Aid Offices for assistance and counseling to avoid payback of funds or other funding/grade consequences.
