Assistant Baseball Coach

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Carl Albert State College is accepting applications for an Assistant Baseball Coach at the Poteau campus. This position shares the responsibility of teaching the skills, fundamentals, and principles of the specific sport. Teaching responsibilities include instruction of physical health, team concepts, and safety. He/she will plan, organize, coordinate, and implement assigned athletic activity, drive and/or supervise team members during away games, as well as other student activities. He/she will be accountable for a share of the field duties, baseball equipment and uniforms (including laundry). Assistant coaches are required to live on campus to allow for monitoring players, room checks, discipline and reporting baseball team discipline when necessary. Other duties as assigned by the Athletic Director.

- Previous coaching experience at the college level preferred
